ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION CASE STUDY

Casino Expansion and 259 Room Hotel encompassing almost 1 million square foot project over 3 years.

CHALLENGE

This hotel was a much anticipated enhancement for the Kickapoo Lucky Eagle Casino patrons, whose numbers have greatly increased. That increase in patronage had created a demand for accommodations nearby the casino. Previously, Casino Customers had to travel several miles into town if they wanted to spend the night in Eagle Pass. Furthermore, the Eagle Pass hotels were usually filled to capacity.

SOLUTION

A New hotel was constructed by Skanska USA, and the project was managed by Yates Construction. FSG was chosen as the electrical contractor for our ability to provide the manpower demands as required. This hotel is also a source of employment for the tribal community. For over a decade, the Kickapoo Traditional Tribe of Texas has been one of the largest employers in Maverick County, Texas. As the Tribes business enterprises expand, it has created more employment opportunities across the region in the hospitality and the construction industry.

In the end, FSG performed on the project as promised and delivered to the owner a first class electrical construction project for a first class property!
